


Template: String-Light Snowflakes


INSTRUCTIONS

Use a miter saw (or ask your local home center or lumber yard) to cut wooden strips for size snowflake you'd like to make, following assembly plan below. Put same-length short angled pieces together so they form Vs.
Use a staple gun to attach to long center strips where indicated on plan.


Large Snowflake Section

(3 per snowflake)



Small Snowflake Section
(3 per snowflake)

INSTRUCTIONS

Print onto paper and cut out. Place template on each short wooden piece, aligning top left corner of template with corner of wooden piece. Using a pencil, trace angle onto wood, then cut along line.
