TEMPLATE

- 1. Download and print these shells onto heat-transfer paper, available at office-supply stores.
- 2. Cut out an image, leaving a 1/16-inch border. On a hard, smooth heat-safe surface protected by a pillowcase, iron the shell transfer, right side down, on a napkin, following paper manufacturer's instructions. Turn the napkin over while still warm, and rub your thumb over the back of the pattern to loosen.
- 3. Let cool, and peel off paper's backing. Seashells will appear as mirror images. Wash napkins according to paper manufacturer's instructions.
