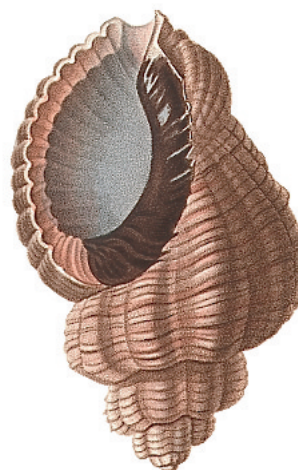
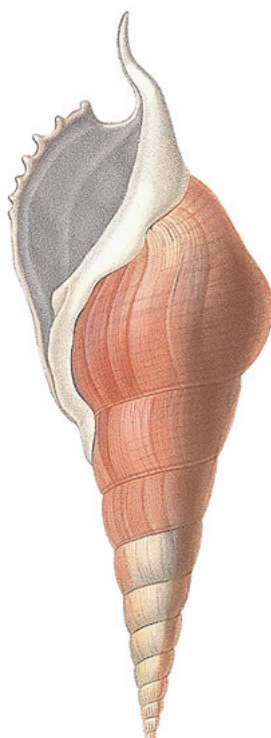


TEMPLATE

1. Download and print these shells onto heat-transfer paper, available at office-supply stores.

2. Cut out an image, leaving a 1/16-inch border. On a hard, smooth heat-safe surface protected by a pillowcase, iron the shell transfer, right side down, on a napkin, following paper manufacturer's instructions. Turn the napkin over while still warm, and rub your thumb over the back of the pattern to loosen.

3. Let cool, and peel off paper's backing. Seashells will appear as mirror images. Wash napkins according to paper manufacturer's instructions.



SEASHELL GLOSSARY

First column, from top: agate mactra, colorful Atlantic natica, Arabian tibia.

Second column: zebra auger, black mouthed cantharus, pink bubble.

Third column: ribboned planispira (2), flowery helicostyla, cake nassa (2).
