

SUPPLIES:

1/8 yard of fabric Marking pen Button Needle and thread

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Enlarge this pattern to 200 percent and then to 150 percent. Pin in place on a single layer of the fabric; trace around it with the marking pen. "These curves require a little more cutting precision than the sash—that's why you want to trace it," Katie says.
- 2. Cut along the line. Wrap the band around your head, centered, to find the center back on one end; sew a button there.
- 3. Wrap band around your head again, and pinch the plain end over the button. In that spot, cut a small slit, then snip it incrementally larger just until you can slip the button through.
